To remain certified as a DBE in the MWUCP, "No Change" affidavits must be submitted annually from the date of this certification letter. Additionally, a complete Application for DBE Re-Evaluation with supporting documentation must be submitted by the Re-Evaluation date.

**In accordance with *Title 49 CFR, Part 26*, this certification remains valid through the re-evaluation date, subject to the submission of the annual notarized "No Change"/"Notice Regarding Change" affidavits and the current updated DBE application package attesting to your continued status as a "socially and economically disadvantaged individual."**

**If a change in the ownership, control or management of this firm occurs during the certification period, you must complete and submit a "Notice Regarding Change" affidavit immediately subsequent to the change.**

If you wish to add to the list of approved NAICS Codes, you must make such request in writing with supporting documentation to the MWUCP participant from which the original certification was received.

Additionally, please note that with proper notice, **The MWUCP** reserves the right to amend, terminate or cancel this certification (or any aspect thereof) at any time prior to the Re-Evaluation Date. **Title 49 CFR Part 26.87(b) states the following: "If, based on the notification by the firm of a change in its circumstances or other information that comes to your (sub-recipient) attention, you determine that there is reasonable cause to believe that a currently certified firm is ineligible, you must provide written notice to the firm that you propose to find the firm ineligible, setting forth the reasons for the proposed determination".**
